Northlake Christian School offers a variety of distinctive academic programming options for students with individual educational needs beyond the scope of the traditional classroom setting. These services are primarily through our Discovery Center and are specifically designed to help students succeed in all areas of academics. These programs range from Gifted, to Content Tutoring, and also Intensive Individualized Core Courses. Each distinctive academic program requires consultation and a team approach in order to ensure the appropriate and successful program accommodation to meet the needs of the individual student.

PRE-K4 - 12TH PRORATION SCHEDULE

Since the school must make budgetary decisions based upon a projection of enrollment, purchasing supplies and materials, contracting with teachers and staff, and deciding operational issues based upon your agreement and representation to enroll your child for the school year, Northlake Christian School retains a prorated portion of tuition if a family must withdraw before/during the school year.

When a student is withdrawn from the school, whether at the request of the parent or NCS, the parents' financial liability for tuition (and any Distinctive Academic Program fees, if applicable) is shown below. When a student enters mid-year, tuition is prorated according to the Delayed Entry schedule below.
